

Enrichment Activities (OPTIONAL)

These activities are optional- you can complete one or more of these or not complete any of them- it's your choice.

READING-

*Read a book of your choice. Create a poster, cereal box, diorama, or a comic strip describing your book.

*Read a book of your choice. Imagine a different ending to the story or a different setting and write how it would change the story.

WRITING-

*Write a letter to your teacher giving your opinion about the Non-Traditional Snow Days (being able to make-up school days by completing packets from home). Be sure to support your opinion with detailed reasons.

*Write a haiku poem about one of your favorite topics- winter, basketball, reading, etc.

WHAT IS A HAIKU?

A haiku is an unrhymed three-line poem. It is based on a traditional Japanese poetic form. Though there are different ways to write haiku, the traditional pattern in English is to write the first and last lines with five syllables each, and the middle line with seven syllables.

Line 1: 5 syllables

Line 2: 7 syllables

Line 3: 5 syllables

MATH-

*You have a budget of \$100.00 to plan 5 meals for a family of four. Use a local sales bill (Walmart, Dollar General, Piggly Wiggly, etc.) to plan your meals. Each meal must include a main dish, at least one side dish, and a dessert.

*Using a favorite recipe of your families (or a recipe you'd like to try sometime) determine the amount of ingredients you would need if you doubled the recipe, halved the recipe, or made the recipe for 100 people.
